This event is being held under Collie Motorplex's Motorsport Australia Topcar Permit and will be a Club event with activities as follows:

- PRA – Test'n'Tune Day
- DRV – Drive Day
- LIM3 – Static Automobile Activities

Event: This is a non-competitive event which will be 10 minute sessions on track with the first lap being a warm up lap and the last lap being a cool down lap

Vehicles on track at any one time will be limited to 8 – 10 cars

\$ 25.00 Motorsport Australia Introductory Licence (on track & parade lap)

Entry: Entry must be made on the official entry form. All entries to be emailed or posted to the addresses listed below. The maximum number of drivers per vehicle is two. The maximum number of entries shall be 50, accepted in order of receipt.

Licences: All drivers must hold, at a minimum, a Motorsport Australia Introductory Licence (valid for one day). Payment of the Introductory Licence (\$25.00) can be made along with your entry fee or complete the 'credit card' details on the licence form and the fee will be deducted from your nominated credit card. Drivers with a Motorsport Australia Introductory Licence are **NOT** permitted to take passengers.

Drivers with Motorsport Australia Speed licences are eligible to take one passenger.

Parade Laps: Will consist of two laps of the long circuit (2.55km) under a 'lead' vehicle doing a speed of no more than 50km p/h. No helmets required and passengers are allowed (one passenger per seatbelt). Strictly **no** overtaking on the Parade Lap.

Passenger Rides: A Motorsport Australia Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) will be permitted. All passengers **must** complete a Passenger Entry Form prior to participating. Passengers must be at least 12 years of age. For a passenger under 18 years of age the Passenger Entry Form must be signed by a parent or legal guardian.

Prohibited Activities:

- Racing between cars
- Publication of a merit, achievement, success or similar activities
- Official timing
- Conduct which could reasonably be considered to be competition based

Fuel: Is not available at Collie Motorplex, ensure you fuel up prior to arriving

Vehicle Requirements:

- Battery secure and terminals covered
- Second Spring on Throttle
- Seat Belt
- Blue Triangle (150mm) indicating position of Battery
- Glass Headlights taped
- Normal Fuel Pump
- Fire Extinguisher (tested) within 6 months of event
- Remove all items from the boot and cabin of vehicle
- Good suitable Tyres, no Retreads

Food & Drinks: The canteen will be open for breakfast and lunch 8.00am to 2.00pm
